#### **PUBLIC INPUT:**

Several guests were present representing different groups interested in two different topics:

- 1) Jim Dullenty and Duane Ferdinand spoke in regard to preserving the old chimney on the Courthouse. They previously spoke with Mark Machler about this as he is concerned about its stability. Mr. Dullenty and others present are concerned about it being torn down. The Courthouse is on the National Register of Historical Buildings. They are not concerned about the exterior brick but they don't want the sandstone torn down. Commissioner Butcher indicated that the Commissioners have discussed this. He doesn't feel it is a bad idea to take the brick off and repoint the sandstone. The structural integrity of the chimney is very important.
- 2) Mr. Dullenty led a discussion in favor of repairs to the Ag Building at the fairgrounds. He is convinced that the fair board wants to restore this building. Those present want to know what the County plans to do. Commissioner Youngbauer stated there is \$75,000.00 set aside in a capital improvement fund and a bid has been received to restore the exterior of the building. At this time no plans have been made for interior work. There was discussion on the need for a licensed engineer for this but at this time the Commissioners don't see the need for this. All agreed that ground work is also needed in regard to drainage away from the building. Before too much work is done it is important to make sure the building is structurally sound.
