

RESOLUTION NO. 11-2018

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A POLICY FOR
OBLIGATING FERGUS COUNTY BY CONTRACT

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners recognizes that Fergus County is funded with taxpayer money; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners also recognizes that it has a duty of fiscal responsibility to taxpayers; and


WHEREAS, taxpayer money is expended when the County contracts for goods or services;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the following policy shall govern the obligation of County funds by contract:

1. Any contract for goods or services that obligates County funds shall be reviewed by the County Attorney's Office prior to being signed.
2. Any contract for goods or services that obligates County funds shall be signed by a County Commissioner.
3. The County Attorney's Office shall maintain a spreadsheet of County contracts for purposes of tracking when contracts are due to renew automatically or expire.


