A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A POLICY WHEREBY FERGUS COUNTY IS REIMBURSED FOR THE COSTS OF PUBLICATION; NECESSARY WHEN PROCESSING PETITIONS OR OTHER MATTERS THAT REQUIRE NOTICE TO THE PUBLIC TO BE ADVERTISED IN A NEWSPAPER


WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners from time to time is legally required to publish a notice in the Lewistown News Argus, or other newspapers, in order to provide public notice of proposed action regarding petitions or requests from citizens for formal commission action; and

WHEREAS, the cost of such publications should be borne by the persons filing Petitions or other requests for formal action by the Board; and some examples of the kinds of Petitions or formal actions are, without limitation, petitions for creation, annexation, or dissolution of a herd district; petitions for creation or abandonment of roads, streets, or alleys; \_\_\_\_\_

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, when such a petition is submitted to the Board of Commissioners, upon filing of the Petition the Petitioner shall be required to deposit an estimated amount of the costs of publication; and after the final bill for publication is received by the Commissioners, the Petitioner(s) will be billed or remitted the difference between the deposit and the actual costs of publication.
