

ORDINANCE NO. 2-2017

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATING
FIRE RESTRICTIONS AND BURNING WITHOUT A PERMIT

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE FERGUS COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
THAT THE FOLLOWING PROVISIONS ARE ENACTED TO DETER VIOLATIONS
OF FIRE RESTRICTIONS AND TO PREVENT WILDFIRES.


A person who violates any provision of any Fire Restrictions enacted by the
Fergus County Board of Commissioners is guilty of a misdemeanor and subject
to a fine of up to \$500 and imprisonment in the county jail for up to six (6)
months.

A person who ignites any fire in Fergus County without first having obtained a
burn permit is guilty of a misdemeanor and subject to a fine of up to \$500 and
imprisonment in the county jail for up to six (6) months.

This Ordinance shall be effective thirty (30) days from the date of its adoption.
