

RESOLUTION 23-2017

FERGUS COUNTY STAGE ONE FIRE RESTRICTIONS

WHEREAS, the Fergus County Board of Commissioners passed a resolution on July 27, 2017, enacting Stage II Fire Restrictions in Fergus County, and;

WHEREAS, Fergus County has experienced a period of cooler weather and precipitation since that date; and

WHEREAS, the danger of wildfire has decreased but still exists;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, that **Stage I Fire Restrictions** are in effect for all private lands in Fergus County.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED, that all activities that might potentially cause a fire, including but not limited to any burning, including campfires; the use of fireworks; and smoking outdoors, except in a three-foot diameter area cleared of all burnable vegetation; shall cease immediately and be prohibited until further notice. Campfires in a developed recreation site or in a fire ring are permitted.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the resolution becomes effective at 12:01 A.M. September 30, 2017, and shall remain in effect until such time as it may be amended or rescinded by the Board of Fergus County Commissioners.


