RESOLUTION ALLOWING THE CLOSURE OF UNMAINTAINED COUNTY  
ROADS DUE TO EXTREME FIRE DANGER

WHEREAS, the Fergus County Board of Commissioners passed a resolution on July 27, 2017, enacting Stage II Fire Restrictions in Fergus County, and

WHEREAS, Montana Gov. Steve Bullock on July 23, 2017, declared a state of emergency in Montana due to wildfires; and

WHEREAS, fire danger continues to be extreme in Fergus County;



NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Fergus County may temporarily close unmaintained County roads to reduce the risk of wildfire. Such closures shall be clearly marked with signs. Violation of such closures shall subject the violator to a fine of up to \$100 per violation pursuant to Montana Code Annotated § 61-8-201.
