

ORDINANCE NO. 1 - 2022

**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATING
FIRE RESTRICTIONS AND BURNING WITHOUT A PERMIT**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE FERGUS COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS THAT THE FOLLOWING PROVISIONS ARE ENACTED TO DETER VIOLATIONS OF FIRE RESTRICTIONS AND TO PREVENT WILDFIRES.


A person who violates any provision of any Fire Restrictions enacted by the Fergus County Board of Commissioners is guilty of a misdemeanor and subject to a fine of up to \$500 and imprisonment in the county jail for up to six (6) months.


A person who ignites any fire 48 inches or larger in diameter in Fergus County without first having obtained a burn permit is guilty of a misdemeanor and subject to a fine of up to \$500 and imprisonment in the county jail for up to six (6) months.


This Ordinance shall be effective thirty (30) days from the date of its adoption and amends Fergus County Ordinance 2 - 2017.
