- Management of outbreaks

Communicable diseases include: Vaccine preventable diseases, Sexually Transmitted Diseases (STDs), Influenza, Pertussis, Norovirus, West Nile Virus, Foodborne illness and others.

We assist clients who have a communicable disease and those who may have been exposed to one by providing resources, education and information about these diseases and how to avoid their spread.
